Fees and Deposits

- Deposit: Contractor shall pay a refundable deposit of \$1,500 prior to issuance of the Meter. The deposit will be refunded upon timely return of the Meter in good working condition, less applicable charges.
- Connect Fee: Contractor shall pay a non-refundable \$30.00 connection fee to open an active utility account prior to issuance of the Meter.
- Usage Fees: Water usage shall be billed at the current District-approved rate(s) as established by Exhibit "A" of the District Rate Order.
- Damage/Replacement Charges: Contractor is responsible for all costs associated with repair or replacement of the Meter and associated equipment if lost, stolen, or damaged during the Contractor's possession.

Contractor Responsibilities

- The Meter should only be used for authorized purposes and at the location(s) approved by the District.
- Ensure proper installation and use of the Meter according to District guidelines.
- Protect the Meter from theft, vandalism, freezing, or damage.
- Promptly notify the District of any malfunction, damage, or loss of the Meter.
- Return the Meter and any related equipment to the District by the agreed-upon return date.
- Accurately report usage readings monthly, as required by the District.
- Contractor shall ensure that the backflow device is always used in conjunction with the Temporary Hydrant Meter during operation.

Prohibited Activities

The Contractor shall not:

- Use the Meter for purposes other than those authorized by the District.
- Tamper with, bypass, or alter the Meter in any way.
- Connect the Meter to unauthorized systems or hydrants.

District Rights

The District reserves the right to inspect the Meter at any time during the term of this Agreement, terminate the Agreement for non-compliance, and withhold deposit to cover unpaid charges, damages, or unreturned equipment.

Liability and Indemnification

The Contractor assumes all liability for injury, damage, or loss resulting from the use of the Meter. Contractor agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the District, its officers, employees, and agents from any claims, damages, or expenses arising out of the Contractor's use of the Meter.

Term and Termination

This Agreement shall commence on the Start Date of Use and terminate upon return of the Meter and settlement of all charges. Either party may terminate this Agreement with written notice.

Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas.



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Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties regarding the subject matter herein and supersedes all prior agreements, whether written or oral.

Terms of Use & Instructions for Temporary Hydrant Meter

- Backflow Prevention: A backflow prevention assembly must be installed and approved by the District before water use begins. Contractor shall ensure the assembly remains in place and functional at all times.
- Authorized Hydrants Only: Use of the Meter is permitted only on hydrants specifically designated by the District. Unauthorized connections will result in immediate termination of this Agreement and forfeiture of deposit.
- Meter Protection: Contractor shall keep the Meter off the ground when possible and out of standing water. The Meter must be protected from freezing temperatures and excessive heat.
- Relocation: The Meter may not be moved to another hydrant or location without District approval.
- Return Requirements: Contractor must return the Meter, backflow prevention assembly, and all related fittings to the District in clean, working condition on or before the expected return date. Late returns may result in additional charges.
- Compliance: Contractor must comply with all applicable state and local regulations regarding water use, cross-connection, and fire hydrant access.
- Inspection by District: The District may inspect the Meter and hydrant connection at any time.
